Admission Requirements

To be accepted/admitted into the Doctor of Nurse Anesthesia Practice Program - MS - DNAP, the applicant must have following:

- Master's degree in nursing or other appropriate Master's degree that provided the ability for the graduate to obtain certification and/or licensure as a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist
- Graduation from an accredited (COA) nurse anesthesia program
- Current licensure as an RN
- Current certification/licensure as a CRNA
- Current Resume
- Personal Essay
- Three Professional References:
 - Immediate Supervisor
 - Two Colleagues who can attest to preparation, initiative, and aptitude for successful completion of doctoral education
- Personal Interview with program faculty
- Criminal background check prior to the start of the first semester, if admitted to the program
- Completed health questionnaire, physical exam, and immunization record prior to the start of the first semester, if admitted to the program.
